



Installation Safety Instructions



Caution: This mount is intended for use only with the maximum weights indicated. Use with equipment heavier than the maximum indicated may result in instability causing possible injury.

Please check carefully to make sure there are no missing or defective parts - defective parts must never be used. B-Tech AV Mounts, its distributors and dealers are not liable or responsible for damage or injury caused by improper installation, improper use or failure to observe these safety instructions. In such cases, all guarantees will expire.

General

B-Tech AV Mounts recommends that a professional AV installer or other suitably qualified person install this product. Great care must always be taken during installation as most AV equipment is of a fragile nature, possibly heavy and easily damaged if dropped. If you do not fully understand the instructions or are not sure how to install this product safely, then please consult a professional for advice and/or to install this product for you. Failure to mount this product correctly may cause serious injury or death both during installation and at any time thereafter. Do not mount any AV equipment that exceeds the specific weight limit of the product you are installing. This weight limit will be clearly stated on each product and its packaging and will vary from product to product.

Trolley Operation

Warning: The trolley can tip over which may lead to serious injury. Only adults should push this trolley, do not allow children under 16 to move the trolley. Push the trolley on the narrow side, never pull the trolley. Do not push at the top of the trolley, push near the middle. Move the trolley slowly. Always park on level ground, never leave the trolley on an incline. Apply the brakes when the trolley is stationary, release the brakes when pushing the trolley

Product location

Please pay careful attention to where this product is located, some locations are not suitable for installation. For indoor use only. Install stand on level ground. When verifying the stability of the structure, consider the following external factors: The strength of the floor, exposure to sudden and severe wind and danger arising from contact with people and /or objects (eg installations in passageways, emergency exits), if located in a public or frequently populated area ensure that the product is out of the immediate reach of people.

Fixing hardware

It is highly recommended that all fixing screws be used where supplied and that the purpose of all other fixing hardware is fully understood. In some cases more AV equipment fixing hardware will be supplied to accommodate different models of equipment and set up configurations. The installer must be satisfied that any supplied fixing hardware is suitable for each specific installation. The fixing kit supplied with the product may not be suitable for all walls. If any fixing screws or included hardware are deemed not sufficient for a safe installation then please consult a professional or your local hardware store.

1. Assemble Base


Connect *item 3* to *item 1* using *item 2* with *items 28, 29 & 31*



2. Fix Castors To Base

Fit *item 4* onto *item 3*.




Note: Lock *item 4* before screwing it into base.



3. Attach Columns To Base

Fix items 6 & 7 to items 1 & 2 using items 27 & 30.




Note: Ensure columns are installed the correct way round with the cables facing inwards.



Important: Do not fully tighten item 26 until Step 6 has been completed.

4. Assemble Control Box






5. Connect Cables

Connect *items 9, 12 & 13* to *item 8*.



Note: Place the column cable under the control box plate for assembling *item 10*.



6. Add Control Box Enclosure



Fit *item 10* onto *items 6 & 7* covering *item 8*.
Fix in place using *items 26 & 30*.

Note: When sliding on, offset *item 10* towards the side of the column without the control box installed and route cables under the spacer plate, this allows easy installation of the cover. When assembling *item 10*, ensure not to pinch any cables.





- ii. Attach *items 17 & 18* to the back of *item 15* using *items 32 & 33*.





- iii. Insert *item 32* into the top holes of *item 10*, do not fully tighten. Allow a gap of approx. 8mm (0.3") to hook on the rail.
- iv. Hook *item 15* onto *item 10* using *items 17 & 18*.



- v. Fasten *item 32* into the bottom holes of *items 17 & 18* and fully tighten all fixings.
vi. Fit *item 16* to the end of *item 15*.




- vii. Ensure level alignment of trolley



10. Install Camera Shelf

- i. Attach *item 23* to *item 22* using items 33 & 34.
- ii. Attach *item 25* to *item 23* using *items 35 & 36*.


Note: Assembly shown for mounting the shelf below the screens. The adjustable arm (*item 23*) can also be assembled to mount the shelf (*item 25*) above the screens.




Note: Assemble accessory mounting arm onto the rail before mounting screens to rail.

Optional Add Extension Bar

For an extended reach attach *item 24* onto *item 23* using *items 36 & 37*.









Attach *item 19* to the rear of the screen using the screen fixings provided. Repeat for both screens.





12. Mount Screens Onto Trolley

i. Using *item 19*, hook the first screen onto the mounting rail (*item 15*).




Note: Ensure castors are set in the braked position.

ii. Using *item 19*, hook the second screen onto the rail (*item 15*).



13. Secure Screens

Secure screens to mount by tightening the locking screws on the bottom of *item 19*.






14. Assemble Media Storage Cradle

- i. Press down the lock on *item 21* and open the cover.
- ii. Use the keyhole fixings to attach *item 21* to *item 10* using *items 26 & 30*.
- iii. Once fixed to trolley, close cradle cover.

264mm x 380mm x 101mm (10.4" x 15" x 4")





15. Fit Cable Cover Onto Column

- i. Separate the cable tray and cable cover of *item 14* and stick the cable tray onto the back of a column (*item 6 or 7*).


Note: Place the cable tray at the lowest position on the column.

- ii. Route any cables down the cable tray and add the cable cover of *item 14*.




16. Operating Control Panel System

Connect floor stand to power and use *item 9* to adjust screen height up or down.

Troubleshooting



Duty cycle: Max. 2 min operation / min. 18 min stop.

System detects and prevents overheating by shutting down for approximately 18 min. after detection.

After cool down period system activates automatically.




If the columns stop moving, a reset and rebalance will be needed:

- i. Push and hold the 'DOWN' button on the control panel until the columns are at the very bottom.
- ii. Keep holding the 'DOWN' button for another 5-10 seconds until the columns react and move slightly upwards.
- iii. When upwards reaction has been identified the control panel function has been restarted and the columns will react as normal to your control panel actions.




Front View




Rear View
